Entry criteria

Candidates require a pass in at least two (02) Science subjects at the GCE Advanced Level in any of the following: Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Further Mathematics and Biology.

Aspiring candidates should submit the following:

1. Application forms obtainable from the Baptist School of Public Health (BSPH), Mutengene or downloaded from the BSPH website at <http://bsph.cbchealthservices.org/admissions>.
2. GCE Ordinary and Advanced Level Results Slips (or if awaiting results, do mention in the application form).
3. A photocopy of a receipt of a non-refundable application fee of 10,000FRS CFA, paid into the Baptist School of Public Health (BSPH) account number: **10023 - 00030 - 00313014774 - 68, Union Bank of Cameroon (UBC)**
4. Copy of Birth Certificate and Student or National ID Card.
5. Completed applications (with chosen centre, Mutengene or Bamenda) addressed to the Registrar, Baptist School of Public Health Mutengene.
6. Applications can be deposited at the Baptist School of Public Health in Mutengene or any CBC Health Services Institution nationwide or sent by email to: goddard.nwenfu@yahoo.com
7. Enrollment is open until the beginning of the academic year in October 2023.
